# Welcome

Welcome to the 2023 Pediatric Colorectal and Pelvic Reconstruction Conference. Celebrating its 10th year, the course originally began at the Nationwide Children’s Hospital to discuss common problems in managing patients with Hirschsprung disease and anorectal malformations with trainees and experts alike. This year, the educational undertaking is now being sponsored entirely by the Pediatric Colorectal and Pelvic Learning Consortium (PCPLC) – a multidisciplinary and multi-institutional organization composed of pediatric surgical and medical providers dedicated to caring for children with colorectal and pelvic disorders. This is the first year the conference is being held in a neutral location without an institutional sponsor. Still, we would like to acknowledge the support of the healthcare organizations that allow the members of the PCPLC to conduct meaningful research in this field and disseminate educational offerings such as this one.

While no single course can check every box regarding training in a relatively short period, we believe this course is a special educational offering that allows for many perspectives from different institutions, surgeons, and care providers regarding best practices for these patients. Over three days, you will be exposed to cases highlighting the workup, management, and long-term follow-up for patients with the spectrum of common and rare pediatric colonic and pelvic congenital disorders. We anticipate you will find the educational offerings informative and

encourage your participation in the discussions. We have expanded the scientific content this year to include 48 abstracts and thank Megan Durham, Caitlin Smith, and their committee for preparing a robust scientific program.

In addition, the course also includes a separate educational program for allied health providers with an interest in colorectal disorders in the pediatric population, including but not limited to advanced practice nurses, physicians’ assistants, nurse practitioners, and physical therapists. We want to acknowledge the importance of our allied health in caring for patients with these disorders and specifically thank Julie Choueiki and her committee for putting together an excellent basic and advanced curriculum for allied health professionals.

You will note from a perusal of the program that there are FOUR rooms that have overlapping content. The primary room in Kiva is designed for residents/fellows/new faculty in the morning sessions Wednesday – Friday. Didactic lectures have been designed by the PCPLC education committee to provide the basic understanding of diagnostics and therapeutics for children with colorectal and pelvic disorders. In that same room thereafter, content will be divided between scientific and more advanced educational material – trainees and new faculty surgeons should plan on coming in the morning and staying in the same room all day. The morning content in Paloma II and III has been dedicated to surgeons with an already developed skillset in the treatment of colorectal disorders. These sessions have been organized by Marc Levitt and Andrea Badillo and are meant to stress the nuances of difficult cases in colorectal and pelvic surgery for advanced surgeons with experience. The advanced surgeon group is then encouraged to return to Kiva for the remainder of each day after their morning session.

For nurses and other allied health professionals, basic knowledge of caring for patients with colorectal disorders will be covered in the sessions in Paloma I, whereas more advanced topics will be covered in breakout sessions in Hacienda. Allied health professionals are encouraged to attend sessions that appeal to their educational need. Lunch will be provided each day in a separate room apart from the meeting areas so that attendees can interact with one another. On Friday, lunch is being sponsored by Legally Mine with the intent of providing health care professionals with valuable information about financial health. We think this will be especially valuable for trainees who are eyeing the end of the training tunnel and need to start thinking about management of real-life issues such as a salary and insurance. Finally, all are welcome to our annual Teitelbaum lecture in Kiva on Thursday at 11 am, which is being delivered by David Dorucher from The Other Side Academy. We think you find his personal story intriguing and awe-inspiring.

We are grateful for the support of our generous exhibitors and encourage you to visit their representatives at the booths we have assembled.

We also thank the various PCPLC members who have dedicated countless hours to preparing content that we hope you find valuable as you care for patients with colorectal disorders and their associated urologic, gynecologic, and concomitant challenges. We thank you so very much for joining us in Scottsdale, and we greatly appreciate your attendance and commitment to providing the highest quality of care to infants, children, and adults with colorectal and pelvic conditions.
